ORDER:

In the Service Rules for Village Revenue Assistants, the age of retirement from service on superannuation has not been prescribed. In the Government Memo 3rd read above, a Committee was constituted to have a comprehensive review of the entire system of working of Village Revenue Assistants. The Committee, among others, recommended for fixing the retirement age of Village Revenue Assistants at 65 years as the older Village Revenue Assistants are not being able to cope up with present work load. Accordingly, the Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, A.P., Hyderabad in his letter 5th read above has proposed to fix 65 years, as the retirement age in respect of Village Revenue Assistants.

2. The Government, after careful examination, hereby accept the proposal of the Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad to fix the age of superannuation (i.e. retirement age) at 65 years in respect of Village Revenue Assistants.

3. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette: issue dated 30.09.2011.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendment to the Andhra Pradesh Village Revenue Assistants Service Rules, 2005 issued in G.O.Ms.No.1849, Revenue (VO) dated 28.10.2005 and published in Rules supplement to part – I of the Andhra Pradesh Gazette dated 01.12.2005 as amended from time to time.

AMENDMENT

In the said rules, after rule 40, the following shall be inserted, namely:-

“40-A Age of superannuation:- Every Village Revenue Assistant, recruited on or after 01.10.2011, shall retire from service on the after noon of the last day of the month in which he/she attains the age of sixty five (65) years.”
